

- Who will be supervising the project?
- How do you minimize disruption and dust?
- What is a realistic timeframe and how will we cook and eat during the renovation?
- What type of warranty is offered?
- References of customers and trade suppliers.
- Check the local BBB for rating and complaint history.
- How will you keep my project on-time and on-budget?
- When do I need to make selections?
- How does your remodeling process work?

OTHER DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

- What existing walls or bulkheads must be considered?
- Does the flow from the kitchen to the rest of the house need to be improved?
- Can the kitchen be opened up to create a larger space?
- Do you need an area dedicated to homeowk?
- Do you entertain? Wine cabinets or food prep area?
- Is the dining room utilized effectively based on your lifestyle or can it be converted into more usable space?
- Is there an area near the kitchen that leads outside? How will you minimize dirt and clutter?
